
Congratulations to **Pierce** House who won both the House relays, as well as overall house points for the day. Here's to many more fun and spirited Athletics Days ahead!

The scope of work includes new carpet and linoleum, interior painting, new lighting and heating and adding Autex wall lining (the fluffy acoustic linking that we have in Rooms 1-6). We are very excited about this. To ensure they have time for these projects, we will be emptying the classrooms in preparation for this work in the last few days of the term.

In addition to this work, the carpet in Room 14 will also be replaced and our normal painting contractor will be continuing our cyclical maintenance over the Summer holidays.
